**VERIZON WIRELESS' PETITION TO INTERVENE**

Verizon Wireless, by and through its counsel Sulloway & Hollis, PLLC, requests that the Commission allow it to intervene as a party in the above-captioned matter, in accordance with N.H. Code of Admin. Rules, Puc 203.17, RSA 541-A:32 and the Commission's Order of Notice dated October 15, 2010. The Commission should grant this request because Verizon Wireless' rights, privileges and other interests may be substantially and directly affected by the Commission's actions in this proceeding. As further grounds for this petition, Verizon Wireless states as follows:

1. The Commission opened this docket to address the Petition of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator ("NANPA") for approval of a relief plan for the 603 area code in light of the predicted exhaust of new NXX codes in the third quarter of 2012. *See* Order of Notice dated October 15, 2010, at 1.

2. Verizon Wireless provides cellular mobile radio communication services in New Hampshire. The nature and terms of any relief plan the Commission develops in this proceeding will have a direct impact on changes Verizon Wireless will need to make in its operations in response to such a plan, as well as the availability of numbering resources to serve its customers. Consequently, Verizon Wireless' rights, privileges and interests may be directly affected by this proceeding.

3. Verizon Wireless respectfully submits that the interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding would not be impaired by allowing Verizon Wireless' intervention.


