At its meeting on September 15, 2011, the Joint Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules (Committee) voted pursuant to RSA 541-A:13,V(a) to conditionally approve Final Proposal 2011-35 of the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) relative to rules addressing net metering for customer-owned renewable energy generation resources of 1000 kilowatts or less. The Committee's approval was conditioned upon the Commission making the changes to the final proposal as requested in the amended conditional rule text submitted to the Committee on September 13, 2011, and discussed at the September 15 Committee meeting.


The Commission met in public meeting on Thursday, September 15, 2011, and accepted the changes as proposed and discussed at the September 15 Committee meeting. These changes were made in response to the September 13, 2011 comments of JLCAR staff. A red-lined copy of the Amended Conditional Approval Annotated Text showing the relevant changes is enclosed. The text is exactly the same as that forwarded to your office on September 13, 2011.

The Commission requests that the Office of Legislative Services determine that the Commission has amended the proposed rule in accordance with JLCAR's conditional
