PETITION TO INTERVENE



2. OEP has an ongoing interest in the issues cited by the Commission in its Order of Notices regarding disclosure of the electric service energy sources and environmental characteristics. OEP has participated in stakeholder meetings and testified before the New Hampshire legislature on SB327 in 2010.


