Dear Ms. Geiger:

On July 1, 2011, Comcast Maine/New Hampshire, Inc. (Comcast or the Company) filed a motion for enlargement of time in response to Commission Order No. 25,175, which required Comcast to file by that date petitions for any utility line crossings that require a license under RSA 371:17. Comcast has asked for a six-month extension of time to comply with the order, noting that, in the Company's opinion, there remain certain legal questions regarding licensing requirements under state and federal law.

The Commission has determined that an extension of six months to file petitions as required by Order No. 25,175 by December 31, 2011, is reasonable. To ensure an efficient and adequate resolution of this proceeding, Comcast and Staff are directed to collaborate on the issues raised in the July 1 filing and report back to the Commission by no later than October 1, 2011, with a status update.
