On September 14, 2010, Soltage MGTCO, LLC (Soltage) filed an application on behalf of Saint Luke's Lifeworks requesting that the Commission grant approval of its customer-sited photovoltaic facility (Saint Luke's facility) to produce Class II renewable energy certificates pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Staff sent a deficiency letter on October 13, 2010 to which the applicant did not respond. After repeated telephone correspondence with the applicant, Staff learned that the applicant was not able to acquire the necessary documentation to complete the application pursuant to the N.H. Code of Administrative Rule Puc 2505.08.

On February 3, 2011, Soltage filed a letter stating that it will not be pursuing Class II renewable energy source eligibility for the Saint Luke's facility with the State of New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission. Given this development, Staff recommends that the Commission close this docket without prejudice.
