On August 29, 2011, Turn Cycle Solutions submitted an application on your behalf seeking certification as an independent monitor for owners of customer-sited sources in New Hampshire that qualify for New Hampshire renewable energy certificates (RECs) pursuant to N. H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.09.

Staff has reviewed the application and believes it meets the requirements for certification inasmuch as you are certified as a building analyst professional by the Building Performance Institute, Inc. Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission has determined that your application meets the requirements of Puc 2505.09 and has approved Tom Kelly's certification as an independent monitor for customer-sited sources that qualify for New Hampshire RECs.
