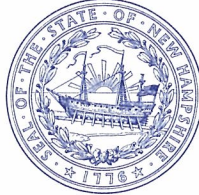

On October 17, 2011, the Commission held a prehearing conference in the above captioned docket. The Commission's appointed its General Counsel, F. Anne Ross, to serve as hearings examiner.
