NOW COMES Lakeland Management Company, Inc. (the "Company"), and, moves the Commission to make an order consolidating the Company's Petition to Approve Borrowing of even date with the investigation into the Company's permanent rates, captioned as above. In support of this motion, the Company states:


1. The Company filed this date a petition to approve the incurrence of two items of long term debt, one in the amount of \$16,727 and one in the amount of \$47,192 . The Company has already borrowed the's funds, and expended them on the completion of Well No. 5 and the construction of additional storage capacity and variable frequency drives, and included the borrowing, and the assets acquired through the borrowing, in support of the increased rate under investigation in the captioned proceeding. All the data relating to the borrowing is included in the record of the captioned proceeding.

2. The resources of the parties and of the Commission would be best utilized if the approval of the borrowing were consolidated with the investigation of the rates.

3. The Staff and the sole intervener in the captioned proceeding have consented to the consolidation.


