On March 5, 2012, the Commission received Satori Enterprises LLC's (Satori) notice of intent to renew its registration to provide electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rules Puc 2003.05. Satori first registered in 2009, and its registration expired on May 1, 2011 pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a). On April 12, 2012, Staff sent a letter advising Satori to submit a new registration application and requested details of its activities as an aggregator in New Hampshire since May 1, 2011. On April 16, 2012, Satori submitted a new application with requested information. In its letter Satori stated that it did not acquire new customers and has been serving only its existing customers since May 1, 2012. The application has been reviewed and the Company has complied with the requirements of Puc 2006.02. Staff recommends that Satori be registered to provide electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.
