On March 27, 2012, Vale Law for Energy and the Environment (Vale Law) submitted an application on your behalf seeking certification for you to serve as an independent monitor for owners of customer-sited sources in New Hampshire that qualify for New Hampshire renewable energy certificates (RECs), pursuant to N. H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.09.
