I would also point out in passing that the substance of PSNH's Motion to Dismiss rests upon its claim that Rule Puc 203.06(c) requires that "All petitions seeking a rate adjustment shall be . . . accompanied by pre-filed testimony and exhibits." However, Rule Puc 203.06(c) only applies to "utilities." *See* Rule 1600.
