Northern New England Telephone Operations LLC d/b/a FairPoint Communications – NNE (FairPoint) is filing for effect June 1, 2012 tariff language changes consisting of:

This filing provides changes supporting the FCC Lifeline Order which revised enrollment requirements that must be met in all states. Federal rules require a signed enrollment form with eligibility verified at enrollment. These changes are ordered in the Federal Communications Commission’s recent “Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rule Making” adopted January 31, 2012 (Order FCC 12-11).

FairPoint Communications originally filed this Tariff on May 18, 2012, but inadvertently combined this with material from other Dockets (Docket No. 11-248, Docket No. 12-133). In this re-file, FairPoint is only submitting the above referenced tariff page, leaving all information unchanged maintaining the originally filed effective date of June 1, 2012. Again, FairPoint requests an expedited approval period, as this Tariff filing is in compliance with the FCC Order and less than 30 days approval is required. FairPoint appreciates the NHPUC’s consideration in this matter and apologizes for this inconvenience.
