Re: DT 12-142 (Merrimack County Telephone Company & Wilton Telephone Company – Investigation into the Decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator)

Dear Ms. Howland:

Merrimack County Telephone Company (“MCTC”) and Wilton Telephone Company (“WTC”) (MCTC and WTC, together, “TDS Telecom”) hereby advise the Commission that they have fully satisfied their obligations under the Agreement entered into on July 10, 2012, between TDS Telecom and the Staff of the Commission in this proceeding. Accordingly, they concur with the Staff’s recommendation, filed on June 14, 2017, that the docket may be closed.

In their Agreement, TDS Telecom and Staff agreed to TDS Telecom’s temporary use of two full 603-NXX codes (one each for MCTC and WTC) on the conditions that (1) such use would not jeopardize the supply of codes within the 603 Numbering Plan Area and (2) TDS Telecom would return the two codes when the period of their temporary use was complete. The dates for the return of the two codes were thereafter extended with the consent of the Commission.

By memorandum filed on June 14, 2017, Staff advised the Commission as follows:

Both codes have now been returned. TDS has informed Staff that the MCTC code was returned to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) effective December 23, 2016, and the WTC code was returned to NANPA effective January 27, 2017.

Staff has used NANPA database tools to confirm that both codes have been returned and are available for use, no longer associated with a particular rate center. This docket may be closed.

By this letter, TDS Telecom confirms Staff's report that MCTC and WTC completed their temporary use of the respective NXX codes and returned them to NANPA on the aforementioned dates. The codes have since been made available for use by other carriers in other areas of New Hampshire.
