Dear Ms. Howland:

By letter dated May 12, 2011, the Commission approved a request to suspend the current procedural schedule until June 10, 2011 following a request from the Office of the Consumer Advocate that was agreed to by all parties. All parties are continuing to work towards a constructive negotiated resolution to the multiple issues involved in this case. Additional time is needed to work through the myriad of issues that the parties are attempting to resolve. We collectively request an additional four weeks to work towards a resolution. This time frame will allow the parties to better understand the likelihood of resolution, or any issues for which resolution will not be achieved, so that the revised procedural schedule may be properly structured to best serve everyone's needs.

To this end, we propose to update the Commission as to the status of our efforts no later than July 8, 2011. If the parties are in a position to do so, we will propose an updated procedural schedule at that time

Thank you for your consideration. Commission Staff, the Property Owners Association of Suissevale, Inc., and the Office of the Consumer Advocate have indicated their support for this request. The representative for Hidden Valley Property Owners Association has not yet indicated his formal assent although we understand that he is also in agreement with this request.
