Service shall consist of the production, treatment, and distribution of water for all residential, commercial and industrial requirements of customers whose premises abut any public street, road or way in which the Company has mains; provided, however, that such service shall only be rendered pursuant to the Terms and Conditions prescribed in other sections of this Tariff and the Rules of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission for Water Service.

A minimum customer charge shall be made for each customer to whom service is rendered under this tariff, based on the meter size shown below:



Character of Service:

Service shall consist of the production, treatment, and distribution of water for all residential, commercial and industrial requirements of customers whose premises abut any public street, road or way in which the Company has mains; provided, however, that such service shall only be rendered pursuant to the Terms and Conditions prescribed in other sections of this Tariff and the Rules of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission for Water Service.

Minimum Charge:

A minimum customer charge shall be made for each customer to whom service is rendered under this tariff, based on the meter size shown below:

Character of Service:

Service shall consist of the production, treatment, and distribution of water for all residential, commercial and industrial requirements of customers whose premises abut any public street, road or way in which the Company has mains; provided, however, that such service shall only be rendered pursuant to the Terms and Conditions prescribed in other sections of this Tariff and the Rules of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission for Water Service.

Minimum Charge:

A minimum customer charge shall be made for each customer to whom service is rendered under this rate based on the meter size shown below:

MUNICIPAL FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

**SCHEDULE FP-M
LONDONDERRY**

Application:

This schedule is applicable to all municipal fire protection service rendered in the Company's Londonderry service area for purposes of public safety, where such service is paid for from tax revenues by and of the Town of Londonderry.

Character of Service:

The Town of Londonderry shall notify the Company, in writing, of an appropriate vote by the governing body of the city, town, village or other political subdivision stating where hydrants are to be placed. Such notification must be received by the Company before the installation of any hydrant affected has begun. The installation and maintenance of fire hydrants, and the supplying of water through such hydrants, is for the sole use of authorized fire fighting personnel for the control and extinguishment of any fire, or for any other use authorized by the Company. Rendering of service under this schedule shall in no way be construed to hold the Company liable to furnish at any time or at any specific point in its distribution system any minimum flow or pressure, either static or residual.

Rate:

- a. Monthly Hydrant Charge
For each fire hydrant installed, there shall be a Monthly Hydrant Charge of \$20.25 per hydrant, per month, payable in advance, from the month of installation.
- b. Monthly Availability Fee
There shall be a Monthly Availability Fee of \$11,015.12 per month payable in advance in addition to the Monthly Hydrant Charge.


Terms of Payment:

Bills under this rate are net; will be rendered monthly, and are due and payable at the office of the Company on the due date as stated on water bill.

Special Provisions:

All hydrants, lead valves, branches and other appurtenances shall be and remain the property of the Company.

MUNICIPAL FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

**SCHEDULE FP-M
LITCHFIELD**

Application:

This schedule is applicable to all municipal fire protection service rendered in the Company's Litchfield service area.

Character of Service:

The installation and maintenance of fire hydrants, and the supplying of water through such hydrants, is for the sole use of authorized fire fighting personnel for the control and extinguishment of any fire, or for any other use authorized by the Company. Rendering of service under this schedule shall in no way be construed to hold the Company liable to furnish at any specific time or at any specific point in its distribution system any minimum flow or pressure, either static or residual. In addition, any future hydrants shall have prior written approval from the Town of Litchfield and the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission.

Rate:

For the use of hydrants by the Town of Litchfield for the purpose of extinguishing fires on property not served by the Company under Rate Schedule GM-L, or other purposes there shall be a charge of \$899.99.

Upon receipt, these payments will be held and applied as a year-end credit to each current customer served under Rate Schedule GM-L.

(Total Receipts/Current Customers) = Year-end credit per customer.



**SCHEDULE FP-M
PELHAM**

Application:

This schedule is applicable to all municipal fire protection service rendered in the Company's Pelham service area for purposes of public safety, where such service is paid for from tax revenues by and of the Town of Pelham.

Character of Service:

The Town of Pelham shall notify the Company, in writing, of an appropriate vote by the governing body of the city, town, village or other political subdivision stating where hydrants are to be placed. Such notification must be received by the Company before the installation of any hydrant affected has begun. The installation and maintenance of fire hydrants, and the supplying of water through such hydrants, is for the sole use of authorized fire fighting personnel for the control and extinguishment of any fire, or for any other use authorized by the Company. Rendering of service under this schedule shall in no way be construed to hold the Company liable to furnish at any time or at any specific point in its distribution system any minimum flow or pressure, either static or residual.

Rate:

- a. Monthly Hydrant Charge
For each fire hydrant installed, there shall be a Monthly Hydrant Charge of \$20.25 per hydrant, per month, payable in advance, from the month of installation.
- b. Monthly Availability Fee
There shall be a Monthly Availability Fee of \$1,069.79 per month payable in advance in addition to the Monthly Hydrant Charge.

Terms of Payment:

Bills under this rate are net; will be rendered monthly, and are due and payable at the office of the Company on the due date as stated on water bill.

Special Provisions:

All hydrants, lead valves, branches and other appurtenances shall remain the property of the Company.

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

SCHEDULE FP-NM

Application:

This rate is applicable to all private fire protection service within a structure or on private property, to include sprinkler systems and privately owned non-municipal hydrants, rendered by the Company in any service area not served under any other private fire protection rate schedule of the Company.

Character of Service:

The Company will make every effort to maintain normal pressures at all times on the distribution system, but shall not be held liable for the failure of either the supply or distribution division of its system to adequately furnish its normal quantity of water when such failure is due to the elements, natural causes, breaks, leaks, unusual or concurrent droughts, or waste or unlawful use of water.
