Staff is in receipt of Pennichuck East Utility, Inc.'s (PEU) request for a waiver of certain filing requirements under Puc 1604.01(a). Specifically, PEU is requesting waivers of Puc 1604.01(a)(1) regarding the submission of internal financial reports and Puc 1604.01(a)(25) regarding the submission of information on their parent company.
