On July 31, 2012, Revolution Energy, LLC submitted an application for the certification of the electrical production from the Exeter Waste Water Treatment Plant's (Exeter WWTP) photovoltaic array at 13 Newfields Road, Exeter, New Hampshire, for Class II renewable energy certificates (RECs), pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) law. Staff requested additional information on September 6, 2012. Additional information to complete the application was received September 14, 2012. Staff has reviewed the application and recommends approval, noting that the Exeter WWTP application was completed on September 14, 2012 in accordance with New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2500.

Class II eligibility requires a facility to produce electricity from solar technologies and to have initiated operation after January 1, 2006. The application indicates that the Excter WWTP photovoltaic installation began operation on June 20, 2012. The total nameplate capacity of the photovoltaic array at Exeter WWTP is .05 megawatts; the facility's New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System facility code is NON 34314. The New Hampshire single certification code for the Exeter WWTP photovoltaic facility is NH-II-12-058.

Pursuant to Puc 2502.13, Exeter WWTP is a customer-sited photovoltaic facility; therefore, its output is not recorded in the NEPOOL Market Settlement System and, as a result, must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application states that Thomas Kelly will serve as the facility's independent monitor as required by the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5).

Staff has determined that all necessary information has been provided to demonstrate the Exeter WWTP's eligibility for certification to produce New Hampshire Class II RECs. Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission hereby certifies the Exeter WWTP photovoltaic array as a Class II renewable energy source effective September 14, 2012.
