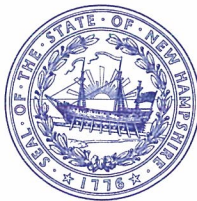

Re: Statutory Changes to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission Assessment

Dear David C. Wiers, President:

On June 16, 2014, the Governor signed Senate Bill 324 into law, revising the Public Utilities Commission assessment statute, RSA 363-A. The effective date of the bill is July 1, 2014. Under the amended statute, each electric load aggregator and each aggregator of natural gas customers is required to pay an annual assessment to the Commission of \$2,000. One fourth of the annual assessment amount will be billed by the Commission each quarter beginning August 15, 2014.

This letter is intended to provide you notice of the revised law and forthcoming invoices you will receive quarterly, from the Commission.

Dear Mr. Weirs:

On September 11, 2012, Satori Enterprises LLC (Satori) filed with the Commission an application for registration as a natural gas aggregator, together with the application fee of \$250.00. This application was re-filed and updated by Satori by a filing made on November 14, 2012, in response to a Staff deficiency letter dated October 30, 2012.

Following its review of the filing, Commission Staff has determined that the application for registration as a natural gas aggregator meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.04. On November 15, 2012, Staff filed its recommendation to approve the application. **The Commission will approve the registration with an effective date of December 3, 2012.** The registration will expire at the end of business on December 2, 2014.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (a), each aggregator shall re-register with the Commission by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of Satori, on or before October 2, 2014. Registration instructions and a checklist of requirements to properly file a renewal registration application are located on the Commission website at <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Gas-Steam/CNGS-Aggregator%20registration%20application%20instructions%20and%20checklist.pdf>.
