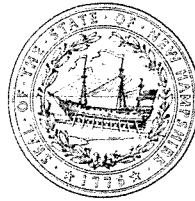

Deficiency Letter



Dear Ms. Abernethy:

The application for Ameresco, Inc. to register as a natural gas aggregator was received on October 1, 2012. Staff of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has completed its initial review of the registration application. The submitted application was incomplete and is therefore deficient in its current form.

Ameresco, Inc. should address the following Commission requirements as appropriate in an update to its registration application:


- Puc 3006.02(a)(5) – A copy of the applicant’s current certificate of authority to do business in the State of New Hampshire from the Secretary of State, if anything other than an individual;
- Puc 3006.02(a)(6) - A list of the CNGSs in New Hampshire through which the applicant may provide service;

Specifically, the applicant’s registration application failed to enclose its most recent certificate of authority, thus did not address the requirements of Puc 3006.02(a)(5) to enclose a copy of its current certificate of authority to do business in the State of New Hampshire from the Office of the Secretary of State. Also, in section Puc 3006.02(a)(6) the application identified three CNGS entities by using incomplete names that partially match approved registered suppliers listed on the Commission web page. Please refer to the approved list of CNGSs on the Commission web page at the following link: <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Gas-Steam/naturalgascompetition.htm> for the correct CNGS identities.

In order to complete the registration process, Ameresco, Inc. will need to address the issues referenced above. These requirements should be administratively straightforward to correct. A letter with the updated information should be filed at your earliest convenience to the docket number assigned to this application (DM 12-294).
