Are the costs of Billing and Payment Service and Collection Services for default service customers recovered through distribution or energy service rates? Please explain the difference (if any) regarding how those costs are recovered for customers taking service from competitive suppliers.

Response:

All Billing and Payment Service and Collection Services costs are recovered through distribution rates. No costs associated with Billing and Payment Service and Collection Services are collected through energy service rates and all revenues received as a result of the charges under investigation are included in revenues credited towards the Company's distribution rates.
