SUPREME COURT

In Case No. 2011-0762, <u>Appeal of Comcast Phone of New Hampshire</u>, <u>LLC & a.</u>, the court on December 3, 2013, issued the following order:

On November 14, 2013, Comcast Phone of New Hampshire, LLC and Comcast IP Phone II, LLC (collectively, Comcast) filed a motion for leave to withdraw appeal "without prejudice." No party has objected to the motion.

The court does <u>not</u> interpret the motion as a request to withdraw the appeal without prejudice to reinstating the appeal in the future. Rather, the court interprets the motion as a request to withdraw the appeal in light of recent developments that have "resolved the central issues" in this appeal and thereby obviated the need for Comcast "to pursue its appeal of the Commission's orders relating to the regulatory treatment of VoIP services." As so interpreted, the motion is granted. The appeal is deemed withdrawn.

Appeal withdrawn.
