Dear Ms. Howland:

On July 8, 2013 Dominion Retail, Inc. d/b/a Dominion Energy Solutions (“Dominion”), submitted its competitive electric power supplier application (“the Application”) with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission. On July 29, 2013, a deficiency letter was received from David Goyette at the New Hampshire Public Utility Commission (“the July 29 letter”). Dominion respectfully responds to the noted deficiencies as follows:

Deficiency #1) Proof of EDI testing with each distribution utility that the applicant intends to do business with, including Puc 2003.01(d)(1) demonstration of technical ability to provide for the efficient and reliable transfer of data and electronic information between utilities and the CEPS in the form of a statement indicating that Dominion has complied with training and testing requirements for electronic data interchange and a statement that the applicant has successfully demonstrated electronic transaction capability.

Response: Dominion intends to initially do business in the Granite State Electric Company service territory. Dominion previously attended Granite State’s Supplier Training Workshop on February 2, 2006. A copy of the Certificate of Completion is attached to this letter. Dominion is currently working with Granite State to schedule updated supplier training and EDI testing. Once EDI testing is completed, appropriate evidence will be filed with the New Hampshire PUC.

Deficiency #2) Certificate from the Secretary of State of New Hampshire showing that Dominion Retail, Inc. is authorized to do business in New Hampshire.

Response: See attached Certificate of Good Standing issued by the New Hampshire Secretary of State on August 16, 2013.

Deficiency #3) Proof of Financial Surety.

Response: Please find attached an original bond rider, dated 9/5/2013, which omits the cancellation provision and the bond, and increases the bond amount to \$350,000.

Please be advised that the applicant's legal name is "Dominion Retail, Inc.", rather than "Dominion Retail Service, Inc.", as noted in subject line of your July 29 letter. The company's fictitious name is Dominion Energy Solutions. The parent company of Dominion Retail, Inc. is Dominion Resources, Inc.
