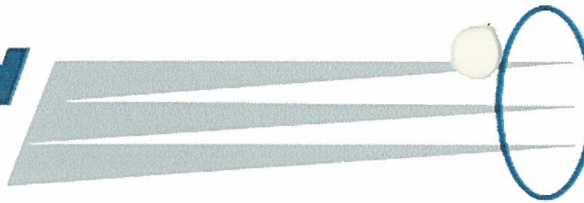

**Re: DG 13 - 255      Concord Steam Corporation 2013 Cost of Energy**

Dear Ms. Howland:

Enclosed for filing are an original and six copies of Concord Steam Corporation's 2013 revised cost of energy filing. An electronic copy has been sent to the Commission.

The changes are the result of corrections required by the COE audit performed by the Commission staff. The original filing projected an under collection of \$99,071. The revised amount of under collection after review by staff is projected to be \$61,795.

There were some other minor changes that affected the estimated costs for next year, LDAC gas charges and other production costs were revised up and wood yard expenses were revised down for a net increase of \$4,595.

The total net effect is that Concord Steam is requesting a decrease in its Cost of Energy rate of 1.2% to \$20.83/Mlb.
