Dear Secretary Howland:

Hess Energy Marketing, LLC (“HEM”) submits this letter in response to the Commission’s Deficiency Letter, dated September 27, 2013, in the above-referenced matter. In particular, Commission Staff has flagged two items missing from HEM’s CEPS application: (1) a Certificate from the New Hampshire Secretary of State showing that HEM is authorized to do business in New Hampshire; and (2) a surety bond that does not include a provision under which the instrument can be terminated with 30 days’ notice.

Enclosed please find a Certificate from the New Hampshire Secretary of State confirming HEM’s authorization to do business in New Hampshire and a corrected surety bond that removes the “30-day opt-out with notice” provision to enable full conformance with Rules PUC 2006.01 and 2003.03, respectively.
