Re: Notification of segTEL, Inc. d/b/a FirstLight Fiber for License to Construct and Maintain
Fiber Optic Telecommunications Cable Across Navigable Public Waters

Dear Ms. Howland:

Pursuant to RSA 371:17-a, segTEL, Inc., d/b/a FirstLight Fiber (FirstLight) hereby notifies the Commission of its intent to place fiber optic cable and associated wires and fixtures over and across navigable public waters in the State of New Hampshire. Specifically, FirstLight plans to construct cable between existing poles over the Contoocook River in Peterborough, NH. The cable will run between pole number PSNH 41/3, FP 5 located at Latitude N 42° 52.5525' and Longitude W 71° 56.8859 to pole number PSNH 4/3-1 located at Latitude N 42° 52.5723' and Longitude W 71° 56.9415 over the river at a height of at least 35 feet.

The placement of cable over and across the river has been reviewed by representatives of FirstLight, Fairpoint Communications and Public Service Company of New Hampshire. Pertinent sections of the pole attachment licenses issued by Fairpoint Communications and Public Service Company of New Hampshire relating to pole PSNH 41/3, FP 5 are enclosed with this notification. We have applied for a license with PSNH for pole PSNH 4/3-1 and enclose a copy of that application.

Attached is the affidavit of James Capuano, attesting that the crossing shall be completed in compliance with the National Electrical Safety Code and with the pole attachment licenses that have or will be obtained from the utility pole owners.
