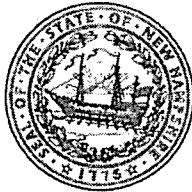

The Public Utilities Commission (Commission) today met in a public meeting and voted to adopt the Puc 2500 rules (captioned above) as approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules on November 20, 2014.
