Dear Ms. Lakritz:

On May 5, 2014, the Commission received an application filed by Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC (Knollwood Energy) for Robert Shone (Shone). Knollwood Energy is requesting Class II¹ New Hampshire Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) eligibility for the Shone photovoltaic (PV) array² and inclusion in the Knollwood Energy aggregation.³

The above-named facility is a customer-sited source and meets the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the application Staff recommends Commission approval for the Shone PV array as an eligible Class II facility to be included in the Knollwood Energy aggregation, effective as of May 5, 2014.

Since this facility is a customer-sited source, its output is not recorded in the ISO New England Market Settlement System and, as a result must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The Shone application lists Paul Button of Energy Audits Unlimited as the independent monitor. The independent monitor's responsibility is to verify the facility's output pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. Mr. Button will report the Shone facility's total output annually to the


customer and to the Commission. The monthly output will be reported quarterly to the NEPOOL Generation Information System as part of Knollwood Energy's Class II aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.09(h)(3).
