On May 7, 2014 Dennis K. Burke, Inc. (Burke) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of natural gas aggregation service. Burke's registration expired on June 8, 2014. On June 23, 2014, Burke provided additional information to complete its application.

Staff has reviewed the information in the application and determined that the filing is complete. Staff noted that that, pursuant to Puc 3003.05(f), Burke's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration, on or before April 9, 2014. Because this is the first time Burke has been late with its submission to renew its registration for natural gas aggregation, Staff recommends the Commission approve Burke's renewal application to provide natural gas aggregation service, effective June 8, 2014, for a term of 5 years.
