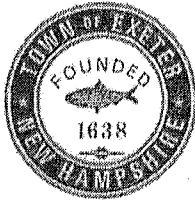
The Brentwood Board of Selectmen strongly support Northern Utilities' request to provide natural gas service to the Town of Brentwood.
