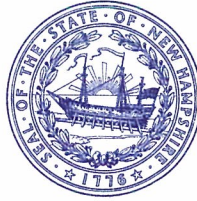

Dear Ms. Howland:

Puc 203.09 (i) requires the filing of a motion to compel "15 business days of receiving the applicable response or objection, or the deadline for providing the response, whichever is sooner." The OCA received Liberty's objection to OCA 1-6 on July 31, and the deadline for filing a motion to compel is August 15, 2014. Presently, as required by Puc 203.09 (i)(4), the OCA and the Company are working in good faith to resolve our dispute informally. Hence, I write to seek an extension of the deadline for filing a motion to compel until close of business on August 25.

I've circulated this request for an extension of the deadline to the parties and none object to the requested relief.
