Executive Director Howland,

At this time Clearview Electric, Inc. d/b/a Clearview Energy ("Clearview") would like to withdrawal its application to become a Competitive Electric Power Supplier in New Hampshire.

Among other business reasons, the newly implemented \$10,000 annual assessment on CEPS's did impact Clearview's decision to continue the process of entering the New Hampshire market. Additionally, a lack of Purchase of Receivables (POR) program creates more financial uncertainties for potential market participants.

Clearview appreciates the Commission's prior time and consideration regarding the application it submitted. If market conditions and Clearview's business plan align in the future, Clearview looks forward to expanding operations to New Hampshire.
