Dear Ms. Lakritz:

On June 30, 2014, the Commission received an application filed by Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC (Knollwood Energy) for Benjamin Brown (Brown). Knollwood Energy is requesting Class II New Hampshire Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) eligibility for the Brown photovoltaic (PV) array and inclusion in the Knollwood Energy aggregation.

The above-named facility is a customer-sited source and meets the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the applications, Staff recommends that the Commission certify the Brown PV array as an eligible facility for Class II RECs to be included as part of the Knollwood aggregation effective as of June 30, 2014.

Since this facility is a customer-sited source, the output is not recorded in the ISO New England Market Settlement System and, as a result must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The application lists Thomas Kelly of Natural Capital as the independent monitor. The independent monitor's responsibility is to verify the facility's output pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. Mr. Kelly will report the facility's total output annually to the customer and to the Commission. The monthly output will be reported quarterly to the NEPOOL Generation Information System as part of Knollwood Energy's Class II aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.09(h)(3).

Please be advised that, pursuant to RSA 362-F, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has certified the Benjamin Brown (Brown) photovoltaic (PV) facility as part of the Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC (Knollwood Energy) aggregation.
