Dear Ms. Howland,

The Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), with the agreement of the Commission Staff and Liberty Utilities requests the Commission suspend the procedural schedule in DG 14-180 Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty Utilities Distribution Rate Case.

On February 3, 2015 Commission Staff requested that the Commission suspend the technical sessions scheduled for February 5 and 6, 2015 in the above captioned case to allow Staff additional time to examine issues related to the Staff Audit. To date, the technical sessions have not been rescheduled. The round of data requests intended to follow the technical sessions has not taken place and the remainder of the procedural schedule has been temporarily halted.

Under the currently proposed procedural schedule (October 13, 2014) Intervener testimony is due March 13, 2015. The OCA specifically requests the suspension of this due date to allow for the previously planned additional round of data requests to take place before filing testimony.
