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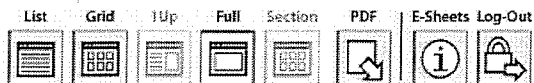

These properties are located at 187 Vessey Road, 170 Vessey Road, and 383 Blackwater Road in the City of Dover and are Map A, Lot 22; Map A, Lot 38; and Map A, Lot 21, respectively. Somersworth states that it cannot issue any prior Commission authorization for it to serve outside of its corporate boundaries, thus it has filed for approval to remedy this oversight.</p> <p>The petition and subsequent factual findings, other than any information for which confidential treatment is requested or granted by the Commission, are posted to the Commission's website at http://maps.ny.nh.gov/Regulation/Doc/14071416-1620.html.</p> <p>Somersworth states that providing service to these properties will not necessitate any water line expansion or associated costs that customers own the service line from the curb stop to their homes, and that it will continue to serve these customers on the same terms and rates as it provides within its corporate boundaries. In addition to its petition, Somersworth provided supporting documentation, including a copy of the City of Dover's contracts with its Somersworth's request.</p> <p>Commission Staff (Staff) recommended Commission approval of Somersworth's request based on Somersworth's municipal, technical, financial, and legal analyses, and also notified the Commission that Somersworth's franchise agreement request satisfied the statutory and availability criteria of RSA 274:22.
