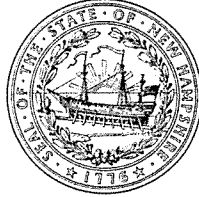

Deficiency Letter

Dear Mr. Rounds:

On August 6, 2014, Standard Power of America, Inc. submitted an application with the Commission to register as a provider of natural gas aggregation service. The application is incomplete and therefore does not comply with the requirements of N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 3003. Commission Staff has reviewed the filing and identified the following item which is missing from the application:

- 1) Certificate from the Secretary of State (SOS) showing that the applicant is authorized to do business in New Hampshire.

Puc 3006.02 Form for Initial and Renewal of Aggregators.

(5) A copy of the applicant's authorization to do business in New Hampshire from the secretary of state, if anything other than an individual.


Regarding item #1, the SOS certificate is a document that you may need to specifically request from the SOS, as it is not automatically provided to you after your registration with that office is approved.

In order to complete your application you should respond accordingly to the item listed above. When responding, please address your letter to Debra A. Howland, Executive Director, and reference the docket number listed on the subject line of this letter.

Pursuant to Puc 3003.05(f), please provide all information requested within 60 days of the date of this later, on or before **October 6, 2014**. Puc 3003.05(f) is copied below:

Puc 3003.05(f) If the commission has requested information or clarification to complete an application for renewal for notification, and such information or clarification is not provided within 60 days of the request, the commission shall suspend the application. If, after 120 days of the date of the request, the applicant has not provided the requested information or clarification, the commission shall reject the application. If an application is rejected, the application fee shall be forfeited and the applicant shall be required to submit a new application and fee prior to acting as an aggregator in New Hampshire.
