I'm writing as follow up to my email of last week. I had failed to indicate the timeline for your response. Pursuant to Puc 2003.05(f), please provide all information requested within 60 days of the date of my email of September 10, 2014. Puc 2003.05(f) is copied below:

*Puc 2003.05(f) If the commission has requested information or clarification to complete an application for renewal for notification, and such information or clarification is not provided within 60 days of the request, the commission shall suspend the application. If, after 120 days of the date of the request, the applicant has not provided the requested information or clarification, the commission shall reject the application. If an application is rejected, the application fee shall be forfeited and the applicant shall be required to submit a new application and fee prior to acting as an aggregator in New Hampshire.*
