





2015 Default Energy Service Rate – Preliminary Mid-Year Adjustment

Dear Director Howland:

Please find enclosed for filing an original and six copies of the pre-filed testimonies and attachments of Christopher J. Goulding and Daniel J. Ludwig and the technical statement of Christopher J. Goulding and Frederick B. White setting forth Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy's ("Eversource") request for an adjustment to the current default Energy Service ("ES") rate effective on January 1, 2015 and approved by Order No. 25,741 (December 29, 2014). As described in Mr. Goulding's testimony, the current ES rate is 10.56 cents per kWh (including the 0.98 cents per kWh cost of the scrubber). The preliminary proposed adjustment is for the rate to equal 8.94 cents per kWh (also including the 0.98 cents per kWh cost of the scrubber), a decrease of 1.62 cents per kWh as compared to the present rate. Eversource will update the rate with more up-to-date information in June 2015. Eversource is proposing the amended ES rate change take effect July 1, 2015 consistent with its proposal to change the Stranded Cost Recovery Charge rate, which is being filed contemporaneously.
