1 **Dr. Mark P. Berkman** is an expert in applied microeconomics. His experience spans the areas of
2 the environment, energy, and natural resources; environmental health and safety; labor and
3 employment; intellectual property; antitrust; commercial litigation and damages; and public
4 finance. He has assisted both public and private clients and provided testimony before state and
5 federal courts, arbitration panels, regulatory bodies, and legislatures.

6 His environmental work has involved the review of proposed air, water, solid waste, and worker
