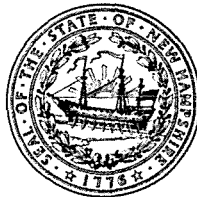

Dear Ms. Lakritz:

On October 7, 2014, the Commission received applications filed by Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC¹ (Knollwood Energy) requesting Class II eligibility for photovoltaic (PV) arrays² and inclusion in the Knollwood Energy aggregation. The applicants include William Wyatt (Wyatt), Erik Travis (Travis), Laura Scheibel (Scheibel), Dale Bellavance (Bellavance), Christopher Betjemann (Betjemann), Michael Thomas (Thomas), Ethan Doubleday-Everett (Doubleday-Everett), and Andrew Gillis (Gillis).

On October 20, 2014, the Commission received one additional application filed by Knollwood requesting Class II eligibility for a PV array and inclusion in the Knollwood Energy aggregation. This application is for the William Covenov (Covenov) PV array.

The above-named facilities are customer-sited sources and all meet the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the applications, Staff recommends Commission approval for the Wyatt, Travis, Scheibel, Bellavance, Betjemann, Thomas, Doubleday-Everett, and Gillis PV arrays as eligible Class II facilities to be included in the Knollwood Energy aggregation, effective as of October 7, 2014. Further, Staff recommends the Covenov array be

² Pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire’s Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Class II eligibility requires a facility to produce electricity from solar technologies that began operation after January 1, 2006 (RSA 362-F:4, II).

certified as a Class II REC eligible facility to be included in the Knollwood Energy aggregation effective as of October 20, 2014.

Because these facilities are customer-sited sources, the output is not recorded in the ISO New England Market Settlement System and, as a result, must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. The following table lists the independent monitor for each facility, the date the Commission approved the independent monitor, and the docket number for the approval.


The independent monitor's responsibility is to verify the facility's output pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09. Mr. Button and Mr. Kelly will report the facilities' total output quarterly to the customer and to the NEPOOL Generation Information System and annually to the Commission as part of the Knollwood Energy's Class II aggregation pursuant to Puc 2505.09(h)(3).

Details for these facilities are listed in the following table.

Further, the Commission hereby certifies the Covenov array to be certified as a Class II REC eligible facility to be included in the Knollwood Energy aggregation effective as of October 20, 2014.

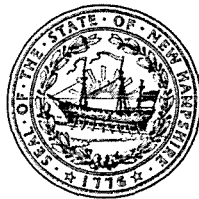


Please be advised that, pursuant to RSA 362-F, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has certified the Wyatt, Travis, Scheibel, Bellavance, Betjemann, Thomas, Doubleday-Everett, and Gillis PV arrays as eligible Class II facilities to be included in the Knollwood Energy aggregation, effective as of October 7, 2014. Further, the Commission has certified the Coven array as a Class II REC eligible facility to be included in the Knollwood Energy aggregation effective as of October 20, 2014.

Accordingly, Knollwood Energy is eligible to be issued Class II RECs for the PV facilities summarized in the table below.
