Dear Ms. Howland:

On October 30, 2014, Freedom Logistics, LLC d/b/a Freedom Energy Logistics filed a Petition on behalf of Cianbro Energy, LLC for a Declaratory Ruling Regarding Rule Puc 2002.05. The Petition seeks a ruling from the Commission declaring that Cianbro Energy was not required at any time to have been registered with the Commission as a competitive electric power supplier during the period when it provided electricity to its parent company, Cianbro Corporation, in New Hampshire.

The Commission issued an Order of Notice on November 6, 2014 scheduling a pre-hearing conference for December 2, 2014 and setting a deadline for petitions to intervene of November 26, 2014. A petition for intervention was filed on behalf of Texas Retail Energy, LLC on November 26, 2014. There were no objections to the petition for intervention, and the Commission granted Texas Retail Energy's intervention during the pre-hearing conference held on December 2, 2014.

Following the pre-hearing conference, representatives of Freedom Logistics, Cianbro Energy, Texas Retail Energy, and Staff met in technical session to discuss issues regarding the scope of and procedure for the proceeding, including the potential to develop factual stipulations for filing with the Commission.

The technical session participants agreed to conduct discovery on a rolling schedule and to schedule March 12, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. for a public hearing on the merits. Staff will report the

parties' progress in developing potential factual stipulations, and will advise the Commission whether the parties believe a further technical conference should be scheduled prior to the public hearing.

Staff, on behalf of the parties, respectfully requests that the Commission approve the proposed procedural schedule. I certify that a copy of this letter will be served electronically on the parties on the service list at the same time it is filed with the Commission.
