As a resident of New Ipswich, I wish to offer my vehement objections to the NED and EnergyNorth's proposed pipeline through southern New Hampshire.

As you are aware, the facts presented by Energy North and its subsidiaries contradict the PUC staff's testimonies as well as the testimonies of the OAC and that of PLAN-NE who all opposed the proposal and recommended that the agreement NOT be approved.

I am unable to understand why expert testimony was overlooked or ignored in this process, particularly in light of the fact that the Commission solicited this expert testimony directly?

In sending this letter, I am acting on behalf of my family, my neighbors and friends in all surrounding communities of New Ipswich who respectfully request that you do not approve EnergyNorth's agreement with TPG.

Aside from the additional financial risk to the taxpayer and the increase ratepayer costs, the potential health hazards presented by this kind of industry in a small community without resources to prevent and defend the citizen's in the case of dire circumstances warrants strong reconsideration of this proposal and ultimately a NO vote.
