SUPREME COURT

In Case No. 2016-0002, <u>Appeal of Pipe Line Awareness</u> <u>Network for the Northeast, Inc.</u>, the court on June 10, 2016, issued the following order:

On June 2, 2016, Pipe Line Awareness Network for the Northeast, Inc. filed a motion for remand to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission). The motion for remand included a copy of written notification that Liberty Utilities Corporation (Liberty Utilities) sent to the Commission, in which Liberty Utilities stated that the "Market Path Precedent Agreement [the agreement at issue] has been terminated given that Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, LLC will not be pursuing the Northeast Energy Direct project." In its objection to the motion for remand, Liberty Utilities has confirmed that the agreement at issue has been terminated.

Because this appeal concerns the Commission's decision to prospectively approve an agreement that has since been terminated, the appeal is dismissed as moot. Accordingly, no action is taken on the motion for remand.

Appeal dismissed.
