I understand that there is an Energy Efficiency Resource Standard proceeding moving forward at the Public Utilities Commission. I just want to make you aware that in HB-2 a provision was inserted to ensure Legislative participation and oversight of that process. Here is the language:

276:223 Public Utilities Commission; Implementation of Energy Efficiency Resource Standard. For the biennium ending June 30, 2017, the public utilities commission shall not expend any funding on the implementation of an energy efficiency resource standard without prior approval of the fiscal committee of the general court.
