REVISION ENERGY, LLC'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

NOW COMES ReVision Energy, LLC pursuant to Puc 203.02 and RSA 541-A:32, and requests leave to intervene in the above-captioned matter. In support of this motion, ReVision Energy, LLC states as follows:

- 1) ReVision Energy, LLC (ReVision) is a limited liability corporation with offices in Maine and New Hampshire. ReVision sells, installs and maintains solar electric and solar thermal systems to customers in the residential, commercial and industrial sectors. ReVision employs a work force of 38 individuals in New Hampshire.
- The vast majority of solar electric systems installed in New Hampshire by ReVision are net metered pursuant to RSA 362-A:9.
- 3) Net metering provides the owners of solar electric systems with the ability to receive compensation from distribution utilities for surplus electricity exported to the electric power grid. Net metering is one of several financial incentives that are critical to the sale of solar electric systems in New Hampshire.
- 4) As set forth in the Order of Notice, this docket seeks to examine the meaning and effect of the phrase "first come, first served" with respect to the 50 megawatt aggregate requirement for net metering tariff availability under RSA 362-A:9, I.
- 5) ReVision is currently developing several large-scale solar power projects in New Hampshire for which net metering applications have been filed or will be filed in the coming months.

As New Hampshire's electric distribution utilities are approaching their statutory share of the net metering limit, ReVision has a direct interest in the outcome of this docket.

6) Allowing ReVision to intervene will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings.

WHEREFORE, ReVision respectfully requests that it be granted full intervenor status in this docket.
