On July 20, 2015, Goldstar Energy Group, Inc. (Goldstar Energy) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Goldstar Energy's currently effective registration had expired on July 24, 2015.

Staff has reviewed the information in the application and determined that the filing is complete. Staff noted that, pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), Goldstar Energy's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration, on or before May 25, 2015. Because this is the first time Goldstar Energy has been late with its submission to renew its registration for electric load aggregation, Staff recommends the Commission approve Goldstar Energy's renewal application to provide electric load aggregation service, effective July 24, 2015, for a term of 5 years.
