On July 22, 2015, Capital Energy, Inc. (Capital Energy) filed an application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service. Capital Energy's currently effective registration expires on August 25, 2015.

Staff has reviewed the application and has determined that the filing is complete. Staff noted that that, pursuant to Puc 2003.05(a), Capital Energy's renewal application should have been filed at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration, on or before June 26, 2015. Because this is the first time Capital Energy has been late with its submission to renew its registration for electric load aggregation, Staff recommends the Commission approve Capital Energy's renewal application to provide electric load aggregation service, effective August 25, 2015, for a term of five years.
