(2)The December 2015 report filed on January 14, 2016, included an amount for the SBC Low Income EAP Funding of \$116,679.16, which provided for a payment of \$39,257.53 to be made to the State of New Hampshire Treasury. The total funding was actually \$116,679.76, resulting in a required payment of \$39,258.13. This very minor discrepancy was identified by the Company prior to making the payment, so the payment made to the Treasury in the amount of \$39,258.13 was correct, but the report was not revised. This report revises the SBC Low Income EAP Funding, which revises the Total reported amount due to State of New Hampshire Treasury by \$0.60.
