Update to License Information
ENGIE Retail, LLC d/b/a Think Energy**

Pursuant to the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, Chapter Puc 2000, Competitive Electric Power Supplier (“CEPS”) and Aggregator Rules, Part Puc 2003.01(e), a CEPS is required to update the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (“NH PUC” or “Commission”) of any material change to the information filed in its application. ENGIE Retail, LLC d/b/a Think Energy (“Think Energy”) hereby submits an update to the information included in its application.¹

On June 30, 2016, ENGIE Resources Inc.,² the direct owner of Think Energy, was converted from a corporation into a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Delaware. The company’s new name is ENGIE Resources LLC (“ENGIE Resources”). Following the conversion into a LLC, on July 1, 2016, an internal corporate reorganization occurred which resulted in a change in upstream ownership of Think Energy. Specifically, GDF SUEZ Energy North America, Inc., an indirect upstream owner of Think Energy sold 100% of the membership interests in ENGIE Resources to its affiliate ENGIE North America Inc., as part of an internal corporate reorganization. The transfer is effective July 1, 2016. ENGIE Resources remains the direct owner of Think Energy.

¹ On December 28, 2015, the NH PUC issued a letter notifying Think Energy that its application to register as a CEPS was granted for a term beginning on December 28, 2015 and ending at the end of business on December 25, 2020.

² ENGIE Resources Inc. was formerly known as GDF SUEZ Energy Resources NA, Inc.

Think Energy is also providing updated information regarding the company's officers and directors.

The changes noted herein will have no impact on the day-to-day operations of the company. Think Energy's company information, including employee contacts, physical addresses and phone numbers, will remain the same. **New email addresses are in the following format: `firstname.lastname@na.engie.com`.**

Think Energy is a wholly-owned subsidiary of ENGIE Resources LLC (f/k/a ENGIE Resources Inc. and GDF SUEZ Energy Resources NA, Inc.). ENGIE Resources LLC is a supplier of retail electricity with a focus on large commercial and industrial customers.

Think Energy is not affiliated with any New Hampshire utility.
