

Proposed Notice to Customers
Pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 1203.02(c)

Subject to the approval of the Commission's Consumer Affairs Division, Granite State Electric will include the following notice of its request for rate relief as part of its regular cycle billing for all customers:

Important Message for Customers Regarding Electricity Rates

On April 29, 2016, Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. submitted a rate filing with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") to increase annual base rate revenue by \$5.3 million effective July 1, 2016. Liberty Utilities also requested an additional annual increase of \$2.4 million to take effect following a final decision by the PUC, but no earlier than January 1, 2017. For the proposed July 1, 2016 rate increase request, the monthly bill impact for a residential customer using 650 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month is approximately \$7.28 (5.89%). The monthly bill impact for the total increase (including the proposed additional annual rate increase) for a residential customer using 650 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month is approximately \$10.03 (8.11%).
