Certificate purportedly signed by an authorized signatory of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission stating that an event of default has occurred under the Competitive Electric Power Supplier Agreement by or in respect of EDF Energy Services, LLC and that, in accordance with the provisions of the market rules, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission is entitled to payment of \$100,000.00 as of the date of delivery of this certificate."

**Special Conditions:**

1. Partial drawings are allowed.
2. This Credit will continue to the Expiry Date and will expire at our counters at the close of banking business on that date subject to the following condition set out below in paragraph 3.
3. It is a condition of this Credit that it shall be deemed automatically extended without amendment for one year periods from the Expiry Date hereof, or any future expiration date, unless at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to any expiration date we shall notify you by registered mail/courier that we elect not to consider this Credit renewed for any such additional period.
4. The value of this Credit is reduced by any partial drawings made. If this Credit is automatically renewed, it is renewed for the then outstanding balance of this Credit.
5. Except as otherwise expressly stated herein, this Credit is subject to The International Standby Practices, ICC Publication No. 590 (the "ISP98"). With respect to any matter not covered by the ISP98 such matter is governed by the laws of the state of Delaware, without regard to principles of conflicts of laws. In the event of any conflict between the provisions of the ISP98 and the laws of the state of Delaware, the laws of the state of Delaware, shall govern. In the event of any

inconsistency between the provisions of the ISP98 and this Credit, the terms of this Credit shall govern.
